NEW FOR 2025! RECYCLE YOUR PLASTIC GROCERY BAGS

The Road District is proud to announce the launch of a new plastic bag recycling program at its recycling center starting March 31. Currently, plastic bags are not accepted in the Township's recycling carts or dumpsters. Plastics can take hundreds of years to decompose. Recycling your plastic bags helps reduce the amount of plastic waste going to landfills and keeps plastics out of the oceans, keeping drinking water safe, and reduces its harmful microplastics from going into the environment which can harm wildlife.

Recycling is easier and more convenient for Northfield Township Residents. The Northfield Township Road District garage doors are open as a recycling center from Monday thru Friday, between the hours of 7 AM until 3 PM. For the 2025 season excluding holidays, the drop-off will start Monday, March 31st, 2025 at 7AM and end on Friday, October 31st, 2025 at 3PM. Please pull up to the north end of the garage building at 237 Melvin Drive in Northbrook, ring the bell and we will help you take the recyclable material out of your car. Please see the following list of materials that the Road District will accept for recycling.

WE CANNOT ACCEPT ANY TELEVISIONS OR COMPUTER MONITORS.

ITEMS ACCEPTED

- Art supplies - Batteries - Bikes - Cardboard - CDs and DVDs - Cell phones/pagers
- Computer Software/Hardware Electronics - Engine/Hydraulic oil - **NO VEGETABLE OIL**
- Eyeglasses - Fluorescent tubes/bulbs - Ink/toner cartridges - Metal - Styrofoam (only clean, white styrofoam blocks can be accepted - please do not bring cups, food trays, foam sheeting or egg cartons or peanuts)
- Tires - **LIMIT OF 4 - NO LARGE EQUIPMENT OR COMMERCIAL TIRE ACCEPTED**
- Transmission fluid - Flags - Small electronics - Therapeutic equipment (cans, crutches, standers, walkers, wheelchairs)
- Household paint (oil & latex, limited to 10 one-gallon cans or 2 five-gallon buckets)

THE NORTHFIELD TOWNSHIP ROAD DISTRICT IS NOT A DUMP. WE ONLY TAKE THE ITEMS LISTED ABOVE. WHEN THIS FACILITY IS CLOSED, NO ITEMS SHOULD BE LEFT ON THE PREMISES. In addition, our partnership with the Village of Northbrook provides an additional opportunity to recycle with an added drop-off location in Northbrook. The Village of Northbrook (www.northbrook.il.us) will be receiving at the garage behind the Village Hall on Cedar. Check the Village's web site to verify the times, dates and list of accepted recyclables.

Please contact your local Walgreens or Police Department for additional places to dispose of your unwanted medicines.

2025 HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE PROGRAM

Since the majority of hazardous materials used in homes today can be either recycled, reused, or can be safely destroyed, Northfield Township Road District Highway Commissioner Tim Rueckert has again entered into an agreement with Tradebe Environmental Services to create a limited Household Hazardous Waste Program for our homeowners in Northfield Township to safely dispose of their unwanted household cleaning and maintenance products.

Our HHW program is a way in which we can offer homeowners of Northfield Township an alternative to disposal of the chemicals in a landfill. The Road District has made it simple. **From 9AM to 1PM on May 31st, 2025 and October 25th, 2025** Northfield Township residents can drop off accepted household chemical waste at 237 Melvin Dr. in Northbrook. **We will be checking identification.**

The following items will be accepted: *antifreeze, cleaning products that are consumer commodities only, charcoal lighter fluid, driveway sealer (limit of 2 five gallon buckets), drain cleaners, paint thinners and gasoline in approved/original containers only, insecticides and herbicides.*

- No medical waste of any kind
- No propane cylinders of any size
- No items containing Mercury
- No pool or photographic chemicals
- No business/commercial waste accepted
- All items must be in original containers

At the collection site, Road District employees will help unload cars, segregating and repackaging the waste. The waste is prepared for shipment, ensuring all DOT and EPA regulations are met. The material is then transported to the Heritage Environmental Services facility for proper disposal/recycling.

How to Dispose of Medicines Properly

DON'T flush expired or unwanted prescription and over-the-counter drugs down the toilet or drain unless the label or accompanying patient information specifically instructs you to do so.

DO return unwanted or expired prescription and over-the-counter drugs to a safe medication disposal site:

- **The Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago's O'Brien facility** at 3500 Howard St, Skokie 9 a.m. to 6 p.m. seven days a week
- The Cook County Sheriff's Office Prescription Drug Take-Back-Program has boxes at the Skokie Courthouse, 5600 Old Orchard Road.

PRESCRIPTION DRUGS AND/OR SHARPS DISPOSAL

Should you have unneeded prescriptions or used sharps, the following programs ensure that medicines don't end up harming our children or in our water supply and that sharps are disposed of safely.

Incorporated Glenview Residents Only

Drop off is at the Village Hall, 2500 East Lake Avenue, on the first Friday of every month between 8 a.m. and 4 p.m. No controlled substances or narcotics are accepted.

Incorporated Northbrook Residents Only

Drop-off is at The Northbrook Police Department, 1401 Landwehr Road. Please bring your medications to the Records or Communication desk. Accepted items include: prescription medications, controlled substances, vitamins and medicated ointments on a 24/7 basis. No sharps or liquids are accepted.

2025 Sensitive Document Shredding

At these one day recycling events, we will collect our regularly accepted recyclables as well as sensitive documents to be shredded.

You are limited to a maximum of three (3) containers, such as paper grocery bags or computer paper boxes, per vehicle/household/event.

Documents will not be accepted for shredding with paper clips, metal binders or any other metal or plastic.
